On August 16, 1992, forty six women chartered Eta Xi Sigma chapter in Oak Lawn, IL, one of the largest graduate chapters in Sigma Gamma Rho history. Under the leadership of Basileus Sandra Kelly, membership includes life members, a "Who's Who in Sigma" recipient, a Past Grand Basileus, Past Grand Second Anti-Basilei, Regional Syntakti, past Grand Epistoleus, Undergraduate Campus Coordinators, a Past Executive Director, a Past Regional Rhoer Advisor, and past and present local, regional, and national chairpersons.

Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Incorporated is a historically African American, non-profit, service and social organization, organized on November 12, 1922 in Indianapolis, Indiana by seven school teachers. The group became an incorporated national collegiate sorority on December 30, 1929, when a charter was granted to Alpha chapter at Butler University.

Sigma posesses a stellar membership. Sharing in the Sigma Legacy are women such as Actress Hattie McDaniel (1st African American to win an Oscar); Politicians such as former Congresswoman Corrine Boggs (1st Woman to Chair a Democratic Party), and current Florida Congresswoman Corrine Brown; Singers such as Vanessa Bell Armstrong (Gospel Recording Artist) and Marilyn McCoo (The 5th Dimension); Artists Annie Lee and Brenda Joysmith and Authors April Sinclair and Cheryl Broussard, to Actresses such as Victoria Rowell (Young and the Restless) and Anna Maria Horseford (Friday, Amen and the Wayans Brothers) and Media Personalities Miss Dupree (Tom Joyner Morning Show) and Merri Dee (WGN) just to name a few.
